Work has been continuing on the development of the new interoperable licence for government and other public sector information which is due to launch by the end of September. The Licence, which will be known as the Open Government Licence Terms, will be supported by the UK Open Government Licence Framework document.

## **SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT REPORT TO SWOP MEETING – 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2010**

### **The 2007 – 2008 Bibliography of Scottish Parliament Publications**

The Scottish Parliament Bibliography covering May 2007 to June 2008 is available on the Scottish Parliament website and copies were sent in hard copy to all SWOP members.

### **Scottish Parliament Leaflets**

The Corporate Publications Team are currently working on various new resources and will be able to provide an update for the next SWOP meeting.

### **New Scottish Parliament website**

- The new site will launch in early November.

The key changes for users will be:

- A cleaner and more modern look
- A site which builds upon the navigational structure that people are already familiar with
- Reworked and rewritten content
- Key content such as 'What's On in Parliament' calendar and MSP search pushed to the fore (i.e. the homepage)
- Improved accessibility
- Video content integrated and embedded across the site instead of just on [www.holyrood.tv](http://www.holyrood.tv)
- Improved interlinking of content through (for example) keyword-managed 'Related Links' and 'Related FAQs' elements
- More extensive use of RSS feeds

The key changes for MSPs and Parliament staff will be:

- The move to a Content Management System (Open Text) will ensure better management of information
- Integrated website and Intranet
- Internal and public-facing content appearing on the same webpages (e.g. a recruitment page that lists both internal and external vacancies)
- A homepage that can be customised to suit the user – i.e. he/she can pick which content ‘pods’ will appear and add favourite links
